WHAT DOES CERT ADVISORY DO?

- + We prepared a budget for FY2011/12 that has been approved.

- + A complete inventory of all CERT boxes has been prepared, so a list of needs can be finalized for fundraising purposes.

- + Thanks to a PG&E grant, we've been able to purchase triage tags for training and each CERT box and a Rescue Randy mannequin for CERT class training.

- + Additional laminated placards for CERT callouts are being made so each CERT Box will have 20 placards.
- + Tools and basic supplies are being ordered for 3 new CERT boxes (Monte Vista School Park, Spray Av Tot Lot and Van Buren) and Fire Station 4 (that serves Pacific Grove team), plus tools for Hilltop to replace what was stolen several years ago.

Gary Greene, Professor Emeritus from MBARI, and Roger Reed, Monterey Fire Captain, spoke to 46 CERTs on April 16th about risk factors of earthquakes and silent tsunamis in Monterey Bay, flood zones and emergency plans that are in place.

Attendees learned about slumps (landslides beneath the Bay's surface) – past, present and likely future. There was time for teams to meet after the presentations to discuss neighborhood risks and possible strategies.

Flashlight & extra batteries

Pen, graphite pencil

Blank 3x5 cards (for messages via runners)

CERT Field Operations Guide (and/or 3x5

NERT cards)

Bottled Water & Non-perishable food (think

Power Bars)

Wear sturdy shoes & long pants

Notebook (ideally, water impermeable)

Lumber crayons (light & dark)
